Step 1. After reaching the journal log-in page, click the 'Create an Account' button to begin.

To create an account, complete the requested information in the following three sections: email/name, address, and user ID & password. Please ensure that all required information is entered prior to selecting 'Next' on each screen.

Step 2. Please enter 2-5 keywords to represent your experience and expertise when creating your account. These keywords are used to connect reviewers to relevant manuscripts.

Step 3. Please email the Managing Editor of the appropriate journal(s) with your name and contact information to notify us that you're interested in peer reviewing for the journal. We will contact you to follow up.
